MAINTENANCE POLICY

To help ensure the delivery of high quality services is maintained throughout each accommodation site, Bethany is currently drafting a Maintenance Policy. While it is easy to lose track of maintenance issues and necessary repairs, Bethany understands there is a need for a more systematic approach. The main features of the policy will include

- A rating system, where maintenance requests are ranked in order of urgency.
- Each rating will have a suggested timeframe for repair or replacement completion.
- A new maintenance register to effectively log maintenance issues.





Aside from monthly safety audits, it is proposed there will be property audits which will consider more extensive building features such as, concrete driveways, brickwork, landscaping, guttering etc.

This new policy will lead to an improved resident experience at each property, for both participants and support workers alike.

TRAINING HOPE COTTAGE STUDENTS

Bethany is committed to helping people acquire professional knowledge and skills that benefit people with a disability and people requiring aged care.

We have recently been asked to share our expertise with the local community by facilitating training sessions for Certificate 3 students from Hope College.







Students were able to learn from Bethany's wide ranging experience on a range of subjects including manual handling, personal care and behaviour support. COVID-19 - VACCINATION ROLLOUT

Bethany has recently been contacted by the Queensland Government regarding COVID-19 vaccinations for our residents at Yodelay and Maidenhair permanent accommodation sites.

They are also offering vaccines for all Bethany staff who would like to volunteer to have it. Consent forms have been circulated to all parties accordingly.

Although we don't currently have a definite vaccination date it is likely to be within the next 3-4 weeks.

The Government has not made it mandatory and it is entirely your choice if you want to have the vaccination.
