#### HEALTH & WELLBEING EVENT — DEALING WITH ANXIETY & STRESS

As the coronavirus pandemic swept across the world, it created a considerable degree of fear, worry and concern in the population at large. In particular certain groups such as older adults, care providers and people with underlying health conditions have been affected. In response, Bethany Care and Hope Church recently held an event to help our community deal with the associated anxiety and stress.

The forum consisted of a panel of experts to provide context and strategies for managing anxiety and stress from a physical, psychological and spiritual perspective. This panel comprised; crisis counsellors from Lifeline, a psychologist from a local practice called Compassion Services and the Gold Coast Police Services regional chaplain.

More than seventy people attending the evening asking the panel relevant and insightful questions. Although coming from a Christian heart of service the content and format was inclusive and there was something for everyone.

The feedback regarding the evening was very positive, and many people commented on the fact they walked away with practical tools to help them and their family.
