We would especially like to thank those in attendance who completed their feedback form. The results of every form has been analysed, with special care taken to read your suggestions for improvement. Bethany has already shared these results at Board level and with all support workers throughout the organisation.

Our highest scores

- 2) Bethany Care treats participants fairly 93%
- 3) Bethany lets participants make their own decisions and choices 92%
- 5) Bethany supports participants to be in the local community 92%





We are happy to report that according to your surveys, Bethany's overall experience score is a Excellent (82%), with the remaining 18% stating it is Above Average

Our lowest scores

- 7) Bethany helps participants to make complaints, and is fair to those reporting abuse, neglect or exploitation 79%
- 11) Bethany supports participants with money handling skills to spend their own money as they determine 74%
- 10) Bethany supports participants to contact help and advocacy when needed 81%


WELCOME TO THE BOARD - IDRIS AKINTOLA

Guests and residents were treated to a delicious traditional Christmas meal with all the trimmings...check out that menu to the right!


A fantastic time was had by all, let's do it all again in December!
