It has long been documented that people with a disability have been 'silent victims' of many forms of abuse including neglect and criminal assault by carers. Bethany will actively strive to eliminate abuse and neglect activity from its activities.

Bethany believes each client has the right to be free from physical, sexual, verbal and emotional abuse or neglect.

It is our policy that any human rights breaches must be reported directly to us to allow Management to fully investi-



gate the matter. We are happy to receive any verbal complaints and lodge them for you if this is required.

Bethany is committed to prevent all forms of abuse and neglect. We take all allegation cases extremely seriously and will not hesitate to take appropriate action where necessary, in order to protect clients and their families. If you have cause to come forward with any information, Bethany in accordance with its Privacy and Confidentiality Policy will protect your identity appropriately.
